

## Contingency plan

### In the event of fire, serious disruption to production or supply failure

To ensure an optimal security of supply to our customers we have prepared an overall contingency plan to be applied in the event of fire, serious disruption to production or failure to supply materials. Date:

#### Fire and serious disruption to production:

BPI has production facilities in both Denmark and Poland. Production in Denmark takes place at two locations situated approximately 650 meters from each other. The factory in Poland is similarly divided into two sites with a public road between the two building complexes. The risk of fire and disruption to production occurring simultaneously at all locations is considered to be almost non-existing. In the event of fire or disruption to production at one of the locations, BPI has the following options:

- BPI are following the Danish Governments recommendations in order to protect our supply chains
- For most of its production BPI has corresponding production machinery at the factories in Denmark and Poland. Consequently, it is possible to extensively utilize the unaffected factory's production machinery for manufacturing the affected items.
- In the event of a breakdown to a machine of which there is only one available, it will often be possible to produce the item on alternative method in the production.
- The management of BPI are acquainted with machine suppliers/similar companies which can be of assistance in emergencies.
- In the event of a serious fire at the factory in Poland the production will be resumed at leased premises in the community to ensure the retention of our experienced employees.
- BPI's IT system is secured by daily backup, which with regards to fire is stored and hosted at another location. Moreover, BPI has a disaster recovery plan for IT, which ensures that the day's data can be restored in the event for fire or breakdown.


#### Supplier failure:

To prevent the supply failure of materials, BPI has adopted following strategy:

- BPI deliberately applies a dual sourcing strategy for selected essential suppliers.
- BPI uses some of the largest international suppliers on key materials - who like BPI also operates a multisite production strategy.
- In certain circumstances, BPI can replace the material with alternative raw materials. BPI is ISO9001 certified, and has well documented processes and systems.
- The management of BPI are acquainted with alternative suppliers throughout the various product ranges.
- BPI is constantly monitoring the supply situation of raw materials components to secure the stock levels according to the demands
